
2023 Virginia Syphilis Screening Guidelines by County/City



- * In counties/cities where the rate of primary & secondary syphilis among women aged 15-44 years was greater than 4.6 per 100,000 in 2023, providers should offer syphilis testing to all sexually active people aged 15-44 years.
- ** In counties/cities where the rate of primary & secondary syphilis among women aged 15-44 years was less than or equal to 4.6 per 100,000 in 2023, providers should continue to assess individual risk factors to determine testing needs as outlined in the CDC screening guidelines.
